Pinewood Derby Steps

Step 1: Get a Car Kit

- · A kit is provided for each scout
- Extra kits are available for scouts, siblings and friends @ \$5 per kit

Step 2: Pick Out a Design

- Templates are provided if needed
- Feel free to pick your own design

Step 3: Cut Out Your Car

- Have the bandsaw operator cut out your design
- Only the designated bandsaw operator is allowed to use the equipment

Step 4: Sand Your Car

Use sandpaper, files, Dremel tools or whatever to finish shaping your car

Step 5: Add Weight

- The car should be near 5 oz in weight but not over
- Use the scale to confirm
- Leave room for paint
- Be sure to include all the wheels and axles when weighing
- If you're adding other decoration, be sure to leave room for those as well
- Use any weights you want including coins and pennies

Step 6: Paint Your Car

- Have an adult help you paint the car outside
- If you want to paint it on your own at home, you are welcome to do so

Step 7: Add Wheels

- Smooth axles and wheels
- Hammer axles through wheels being sure to not hammer too tightly

Step 8: Test Your Car

Run the car on the test track and tune it as necessary

Step 9: Take It Home

- Take the car home and keep it safe
- Bring it back in for the weigh in
- Come watch it race on race day
